2024 EUROPEAN HERITAGE DAYS

Guided tours, exhibitions, concerts, workshops... As every year, Le Corbusier sites are offering a rich programme of activities to enable visitors to discover what makes this modern architectural heritage so unique.

This year's special feature? **Two exhibitions, *Destinations Le Corbusier: promenades architecturales* and *Depuis nos corbus***, will be on show simultaneously in no fewer than nine cities across three countries as part of this year's event dedicated to 'networks, itineraries and connections'! A way of highlighting the close connections between Le Corbusier's works and inviting visitors to travel and discover this cultural route that crosses Europe and the continents...

This programme invites you to discover all the activities organised by the sites on the *Destinations Le Corbusier: architectural promenades* cultural route, which has been certified as a Council of Europe cultural route since 2019. This itinerary now includes almost thirty sites and architectural ensembles, some of which are also on UNESCO's World Heritage List as part of *The Architectural Work of Le Corbusier, an Outstanding Contribution to the Modern Movement*. Discover also the activities planned by other cultural routes in areas where several European narratives meet.

WHAT ARE THE CULTURAL ROUTES OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE?

The Council of Europe's Cultural Routes are an invitation to travel and discover Europe's rich and diverse heritage, bringing people together in places of history and heritage. They embody the values of the Council of Europe: human rights, cultural diversity, intercultural dialogue and mutual cross-border exchange. The Cultural Routes programme was launched by the Council of Europe in 1987 and now includes 48 routes across Europe, such as Santiago de Compostela Pilgrim Routes, the Impressionisms Routes, the European Route of Historic Gardens, etc.

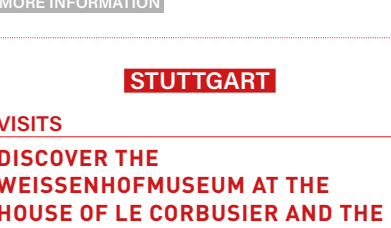
THE ASSOCIATION OF LE CORBUSIER SITES, A NETWORK FOR LE CORBUSIER HERITAGE SITES

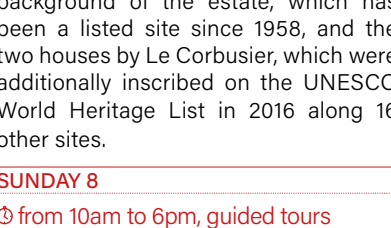

Free entrance at the Weissenhofmuseum and guided tours of the Weissenhof Estate, a milestone of architectural modernism built in 1927 by 17 international architects, are organized on Sunday. The guided tours (in German language, no interior visits) explain the background of the estate, which has been a listed site since 1958, and the two houses by Le Corbusier, which were additionally inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List in 2016 along 16 other sites.
