Guided tours, exhibitions, workshops... As every year, corbusean sites are offering a rich and varied programme to help discover this exceptional architectural heritage, a pillar of the Modern Movement.

This year’s special feature? **A focus on younger audience!** Treasure hunts, riddle games, drawing competitions, educational workshops... In addition to their usual events, the members of the Association of Le Corbusier Sites and the European Federation of Associations of Inhabitants of Le Corbusier Housing Units are highlighting the importance of children and families, with activities designed to inspire curiosity and a passion for architecture.

This programme invites you to discover all the activities organised by the sites on the *Destinations Le Corbusier: architectural promenades Cultural Route*, which has been certified as a Council of Europe Cultural Route since 2019. This itinerary now includes almost thirty sites and architectural ensembles, some of which are also on UNESCO’s World Heritage List as part of *The Architectural Work of Le Corbusier, an Outstanding Contribution to the Modern Movement*.

WHAT ARE THE CULTURAL ROUTES OF THE COUNCIL OF EUROPE?

The Council of Europe’s Cultural Routes are an invitation to travel and discover Europe’s rich and diverse heritage, bringing people together in places of history and heritage. They embody the values of the Council of Europe: human rights, cultural diversity, intercultural dialogue and cross-border exchange. The Cultural Routes programme was launched by the Council of Europe in 1987 and now includes 49 routes across Europe, such as Santiago de Compostela Pilgrim Routes, the Impressionisms Routes, the European Route of Historic Gardens, etc.

Since 2010, the ASLC has been animating and coordinating a network of stakeholders responsible for preserving and promoting Le Corbusier sites in France and internationally. Alongside the Fondation Le Corbusier, the ASLC is involved in the Unesco World Heritage inscription and manages the Council of Europe’s Cultural Route dedicated to Le Corbusier’s heritage.
