



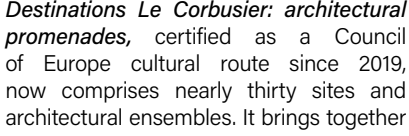

2026 EUROPEAN HERITAGE DAYS

Guided tours, exhibitions, concerts, workshops, games, special openings... To mark European Heritage Days, the sites on the European cultural route *Destinations Le Corbusier: architectural promenades* invite you to explore Le Corbusier’s architectural legacy through a rich and varied programme of events.

LE CORBUSIER’S SITES: AN INTERNATIONALLY RECOGNISED HERITAGE

Destinations Le Corbusier: architectural promenades, certified as a Council of Europe cultural route since 2019, now comprises nearly thirty sites and architectural ensembles. It brings together Le Corbusier’s iconic works to enable as many people as possible to better understand their history, their distinctive features and their shared heritage.

Among these sites, 17 works spread across 7 countries and 3 continents are also inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List under the title *The Architectural Work of Le Corbusier: an Outstanding Contribution to the Modern Movement*. These two forms of recognition are complementary: inscription on the World Heritage List aims to preserve the Outstanding Universal Value of a collection of 17 major works; while the cultural route brings together a broader heritage to promote awareness, discovery and sharing.

THE ASSOCIATION OF LE CORBUSIER SITES, A NETWORK FOR LE CORBUSIER HERITAGE SITES

Since 2010, the ASLC has been animating and coordinating a network of stakeholders responsible for preserving and promoting Le Corbusier sites in France and internationally. Alongside the Fondation Le Corbusier, the ASLC is involved in the UNESCO World Heritage inscription and manages the Council of Europe’s cultural route dedicated to Le Corbusier’s heritage.

The Weissenhofsiedlung, built in 1927 by 17 international architects, is an icon of modern architecture. It has been a protected monument since 1958. Since 2016, Le Corbusier’s two houses have been inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List alongside 16 other sites.
